

Case Scenario Part 2

The measures that were put in place for Shaun by his Named Person are reviewed and as part of this the Named Person speaks to both Shaun and his mum again. The Named Person is still slightly concerned as Shaun has now had absences from school and is still displaying challenging and aggressive behaviour towards both pupils and staff.

On speaking to Shaun he is reluctant to talk at first but then tells his Named Person that his mum isn't feeling too well just now and needs to sleep a lot. In the mornings it's his sister who gets him up and ready for school. He feels unhappy that his dad isn't living with them anymore and his mum won't let him see him. When asked about the trouble at school with other children he said that he had fallen out with some friends and then became withdrawn and didn't want to talk anymore.

Following this discussion the Named Person spoke to mum about her worries and what Shaun had told her.

Jennifer told the Named Person that she had recently found out that she was pregnant which had been a shock to her as she had separated from her husband and the pregnancy wasn't planned. Due to the pregnancy she had been feeling very tired and struggled to get up in the morning. She found Shaun's behaviour had been getting worse and he was lashing out at her and Helen. Shaun had become very aggressive and she found his behaviour challenging which made it even more difficult to get him to school on time. She said that Helen had been a great help to her.
